



Day 1: Arrival in Jaipur and Sightseeing

- **Arrival:** Reach Jaipur by 3 PM and check-in at your hotel.
- **Afternoon:**
 - **City Palace:** A stunning blend of Mughal and Rajasthani architecture. Visit the museum inside that showcases royal costumes, artifacts, and weapons.
 - **Jantar Mantar:** UNESCO World Heritage site, this astronomical observatory houses the world's largest stone sundial.
 - **Hawa Mahal:** Admire the iconic "Palace of Winds," known for its unique five-story exterior and intricate latticework.
- **Evening:**
 - Explore *Johari Bazaar* for traditional jewelry, textiles, and handicrafts.
 - Dinner at a local restaurant (*LMB* or *Chokhi Dhani* for a traditional Rajasthani experience).

Day 2: Jaipur Full-Day Sightseeing

- **Morning:**
 - **Amber Fort:** Visit the majestic Amber Fort, known for its artistic Hindu-style elements. Enjoy an elephant or jeep ride to the fort. Don't miss the *Sheesh Mahal* (Mirror Palace).
 - **Jal Mahal:** Stop for a photo session at the serene Water Palace, located in the middle of Man Sagar Lake.
- **Afternoon:**
 - **Albert Hall Museum:** A beautiful Indo-Saracenic structure housing collections of art, jewelry, paintings, and artifacts.
 - **Birla Temple:** This modern white-marble temple dedicated to Lord Vishnu is a peaceful retreat in the city.
- **Evening:**
 - Head to *Chokhi Dhani* for a traditional Rajasthani village-themed dinner. Enjoy folk dances, camel rides, puppet shows, and traditional cuisine.

Day 3: Jaipur to Udaipur (6-7 Hours Drive)

- **Morning:**
 - Have an early breakfast and depart for Udaipur (approximately 6-7 hours).
 - Optional: Enroute, visit *Rajasthan's Kishangarh Fort* or *Ajmer Sharif* if time permits.



- **Afternoon:**
 - Arrive in Udaipur and check-in at the hotel.
 - **Lake Pichola Boat Ride:** Take a boat ride on the lake, visit *Jag Mandir*, and enjoy views of the *Lake Palace*.
 - **Evening:**
 - Relax by the lake and enjoy a quiet evening walk or dinner at a lakeside restaurant with sunset views (*Ambrai* or *Upre* are popular choices).
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Day 4: Udaipur Full-Day Sightseeing

- **Morning:**
 - **City Palace Complex:** Visit the grand City Palace, one of the largest in Rajasthan. Explore the museums, royal courtyards, and art galleries. Don't miss the *Crystal Gallery*, which houses a rare collection of crystal artifacts.
 - **Jagdish Temple:** Just a short walk from the palace, this Indo-Aryan temple is dedicated to Lord Vishnu.
 - **Afternoon:**
 - **Saheliyon Ki Bari:** A beautifully landscaped garden with fountains, lotus pools, and marble pavilions. It was designed for the queen and her maidens.
 - **Vintage Car Museum:** A unique collection of antique cars used by the Maharajas of Udaipur.
 - **Evening:**
 - Visit *Fateh Sagar Lake* for a relaxing stroll or boat ride. You can also explore the *Moti Magri* (Pearl Hill), where a bronze statue of Maharana Pratap overlooks the lake.
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Day 5: Udaipur Local Sightseeing and Departure

- **Morning:**
 - **Monsoon Palace:** Drive up to this hilltop palace for panoramic views of Udaipur and the surrounding lakes.
 - Explore some last-minute sightseeing or shopping for traditional Rajasthani items such as handicrafts, jewelry, or paintings in the local markets.
- **Afternoon:**
 - **Departure:** Drop-off at Udaipur Railway Station or Maharana Pratap Airport for your return journey.
