



Day 1: Arrival in Jaipur – Hotel Check-in & Local Sightseeing

- **Jal Mahal (Photo Stop):** Palace set in the middle of Man Sagar Lake, perfect for photography.
- **Local Market Visit:** Explore Bapu Bazaar & Johari Bazaar for handicrafts, textiles, and jewelry.
- **Overnight Stay in Jaipur**

Day 2: Jaipur Local Sightseeing

- **Amber Fort:** UNESCO World Heritage site known for its Sheesh Mahal (Mirror Palace) and grand courtyards.
- **Jaigarh Fort:** Famous for the world's largest cannon on wheels, Jaivana Cannon, and panoramic city views.
- **Nahargarh Fort:** Scenic spot overlooking the Pink City, ideal for sunset views.
- **City Palace:** Blend of Mughal and Rajasthani architecture, housing museums of royal artifacts.
- **Jantar Mantar:** 18th-century astronomical observatory with unique instruments.
- **Hawa Mahal:** "Palace of Winds" with 953 windows designed for royal ladies.
- **Overnight Stay in Jaipur**
