



Day 1: Arrival in Guwahati → Kamakhya Temple → Shillong | Umiam Lake

- Arrive at Guwahati Airport/Railway Station and meet your private driver.
- Proceed for Darshan at Kamakhya Temple, one of the most revered Shakti Peethas in India. Spend time at the temple complex for darshan and prayers.
- After darshan, begin your scenic drive towards Shillong, the capital of Meghalaya.
- En route, stop at Umiam Lake, a beautiful reservoir surrounded by Meghalaya's green hills. Enjoy the views and take some photographs.
- Continue towards Shillong and check in at your hotel.
- Evening at leisure. You may explore the local market or simply relax after the journey.

Day 2: Shillong Local Sightseeing → Transfer to Cherrapunji

After breakfast, check out and explore the major attractions of Shillong.

Visit:

- Ward's Lake – a peaceful lake located in the heart of Shillong.
- Shillong Peak – enjoy panoramic views of Shillong and the surrounding hills, subject to weather and visibility.
- Elephant Falls – one of the most popular waterfalls around Shillong.
- Cathedral of Mary Help of Christians – a beautiful and prominent church in Shillong.
- Police Bazaar – Shillong's main commercial area, where you can explore local shops and markets.

Later, drive towards Cherrapunji (Sohra).

The journey itself is scenic, with winding mountain roads, forested hills and several viewpoints along the way.

On arrival in Cherrapunji, check in to your hotel and relax.

Day 3: Cherrapunji Local Sightseeing

After breakfast, set out to explore the natural beauty of Cherrapunji.

Visit:

- Nohkalikai Falls – one of India's most spectacular waterfalls and one of the iconic sights of Meghalaya.
- Seven Sisters Falls – a magnificent waterfall viewpoint, particularly impressive during the monsoon.
- Mawsmi Cave – explore the natural limestone formations inside this accessible cave.
- Eco Park – enjoy beautiful views of the surrounding valleys and waterfalls.
- Arwah Cave – optional depending on time, weather and your interest.

Spend the day enjoying Meghalaya's landscapes, waterfalls and limestone formations.

Return to the hotel by evening and relax.

Day 4: Double Decker Living Root Bridge & Rainbow Falls Excursion

After an early breakfast, prepare for the most adventurous day of your Meghalaya trip.

Drive towards Tyrna Village, the starting point for the trek to the famous Nongriat Double Decker Living Root Bridge.

The trek involves a substantial number of steps through Meghalaya's tropical forest and can be physically demanding. Take your time, stay hydrated and follow your local guide's instructions.

Upon reaching Nongriat, explore the remarkable Double Decker Living Root Bridge, created by generations of Khasi communities using the roots of living rubber trees.

If weather and trail conditions permit, continue towards Rainbow Falls.

Spend some time enjoying the natural surroundings before beginning the return trek towards Tyrna.



After completing the trek, meet your driver and return to Cherrapunji.

Important: This is the most physically demanding day of the itinerary. The trek should not be treated as a casual sightseeing excursion. Trail conditions can become slippery, particularly during or after rainfall, and the itinerary may need to be modified depending on local weather and safety conditions.

Overnight: Cherrapunji

Day 5: Cherrapunji → Guwahati Departure

Enjoy breakfast at the hotel and check out.

Begin your drive from Cherrapunji towards Guwahati.

The journey will take you through Meghalaya's beautiful hills and countryside. Depending on your departure schedule, you may stop for refreshments or photographs along the way.

On reaching Guwahati, you will be dropped at Guwahati Airport/Railway Station for your onward journey.

Your beautiful Meghalaya holiday comes to an end with wonderful memories of the hills, waterfalls, forests and living root bridges.

Meals: Breakfast

- Meghalaya is primarily a nature and experience destination, so the journey involves winding mountain roads, walking and changing weather conditions.
- Distances that look short on the map can take considerably longer because of hilly terrain and road conditions.
- Waterfalls and greenery are at their best during the monsoon, but rain can also affect road and trail conditions.
- Hotels in Meghalaya may not offer the same room size, infrastructure or facilities that you would expect from hotels in major metropolitan cities.
- Sightseeing schedules may occasionally need to be adjusted because of weather, road conditions or local restrictions. Safety will always take priority.
